

Rules and Regulations

Club members are obligated to abide by all of the following rules and regulations during any scheduled club event. There is policy to deal with members, whose actions or personal conduct may be considered detrimental to the club or is considered to be unbecoming to Jeep® Club members, or deemed to be of a threatening or hate related nature as determined by a Peer Review Board. Any violation of these rules will result in a violation notification being issued. Consequences pending include review by a Peer Review board and possible termination of membership.

1. I will be a good sportsman and conservationist. I recognize that people judge all club members by my actions. I will promote sportsmanlike conduct through my actions and influence with other Jeep® owners.
2. There will be no consumption of alcohol during any club event other than at designated times (i.e. designated campsites). Substance abuse will not be tolerated at any time.
3. I will not trespass on other people's property and will respect their rights. I will not operate my Jeep® where prohibited during any club event.
4. I will not litter nor pollute lakes or streams. I will carry out all that I carry in.
5. I will not interfere with or harass hikers, skiers, fishermen or other sportsmen. I will respect their rights.
6. I will know (or endeavour to learn) and obey all Federal, Provincial (Highway Traffic Act) and local rules regulating the operation of my Jeep®
7. I will not harass animal life. I will avoid areas posted for the protection of wildlife. I will not wash my Jeep® in or near lakes, rivers, streams, or ponds out of respect for the environment. I will not intentionally damage living trees, shrubs or other natural features.
8. I will hold a valid drivers license and proof of insurance during all club events.
9. I will not use profanity during any club event.
10. I will lend a helping hand when I see vehicles in distress
11. I will carry no firearms, fireworks or sirens.
12. Pets will be allowed at off pavement activities at the organizers discretion. If pets are on the trail they are to be on a leash at all times. The pet owner is responsible for the control and handling of their pet. Also they are responsible for picking up after their pets. Other members are to respect the pets that are on the trail and keep their distance unless permission is granted by the pet owner. The event organizer will reserve the right to ask the pet owner to remove their pet from the event at their discretion should a problem arise.

14. I understand that neither the London & Area Jeep® Owners Club nor any of its members can be held responsible for any damage that may occur to my vehicle while attending any club event.
